Founded in 1992, Covenant High School is a college preparatory day school with a liberal arts curriculum. As a high school only, the school has 561 alumni. Faculty collaborate to emphasize cross-curricular connection throughout the curriculum. Covenant aspires for graduates to be expert communicators, seek truth, steward God's creation, pursue their calling, serve others, love artistic beauty, and embrace Christian community.

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Accreditation Covenant High School is a fully accredited institution through the Association of Christian Schools International (ACSI).

Faculty

80% of the Covenant High School faculty hold post-graduate degrees. Our highly qualified and experienced educators are committed to academic excellence and the spiritual nurture of students. 90% of the faculty has over 5 years of teaching experience.

School Achievements

- 84% of students taking AP courses score 3 or higher. 33% of students taking an AP course score a 5.
- In the last three years, 62% of our graduating seniors have been named Washington State Honor Awardees. This is the annual honor awarded to the top 10% of eligible college bound seniors in the state by the Washington State Superintendent of Public Instruction.
- Our underclassmen take the Terra Nova Standardized Achievement Test each spring; over the last three years they have ranked in the top 10% nationally.
- Over the last three years, our students' PSAT scores place them as a group in the top 20% nationally.
- Over the last three years, our students' SAT scores in the top 20% of college-bound seniors nationally.
- Over the last four years, five students have received National Merit Recognition.

UK and France Historical Tour

Juniors and Seniors attend a biannual United Kingdom and France historical tour. Students explore England, Scotland and France on a 15-day historical tour. Sites of literary, historical and cultural value are explored. Curricular connections are made to the tour throughout the student's four years at Covenant.

Senior Rhetoric Thesis

Students are required to take four years of speech. This culminates in a senior rhetoric class that teaches methods of classical composition and oratory. Students propose a thesis on a contemporary issue of their choosing and argue their thesis before classmates and faculty in a final speech.

Curriculum

Covenant High School's curriculum is a liberal arts curriculum with an emphasis on challenging students and creating cross-curricular connections between the subjects. The English curriculum centers on the study of classics, while developing strong composition skills. The History curriculum teaches eras and periods that correspond to English class, while making several curricular connections to the UK and France Historical tour. All science courses emphasize learning scientific inquiry through numerous creative opportunities for project-based learning. Students are challenged to take Math all four years. Students are required to take fine arts, Spanish, and four years of speech, culminating in a senior rhetoric thesis. There are many elective options offered including interface design and technology and Latin.
