



INSTRUCTIONS FOR NEW APPLICANTS

Covenant High School is a Christ-focused community of students that embrace academic excellence. We are excited to receive your application. Please reach out to Admissions and Marketing Director Logan Hope with any questions during this process.

Step 1. Complete and submit all parts of the application. Please include the following:

- Parent questionnaire
- Student questionnaire
- Application fee (\$50.00 non-refundable)

Step 2. Send the church reference form to your pastor. They are to complete the form and return it directly to Covenant High School.

Step 3. Send the school reference form to your current school. The school is to complete the reference form and attach a **photocopy** of 7th and 8th grade school records. This is to be returned directly to Covenant High School. Homeschoolers should supply a photocopy of achievement test results, sample of the student's work, and a description of course work completed for grades 7 and 8.

Step 4. Once we have received the completed questionnaires, the application fee, photocopies of school records, teacher reference, and pastoral reference, the admission interview for the student and at least one parent or guardian will be arranged.

Step 5. All applicants will be tested. Testing takes place in early February. Students may arrange and early testing date, if they prefer.

Step 6. An admission decision will normally be made within two weeks after all steps in the process have been completed.

Covenant High School Tuition and Fees for the 2019 – 2020 School Year

Tuition Rates Annually / Monthly - 10 Months

1st student enrolled at CHS: \$8,950 / \$895 per month

2nd student enrolled at CHS: \$8,145 / \$815 per month

3rd student enrolled at CHS: \$7,340 / \$734 per month

Tuition Discounts

A 5% tuition discount is available to families of CHS students if both (1) they have other school age children and all of those children attend either a K-8 Christian school or homeschool and (2) all of their children eligible attend CHS.

Tuition Payment Plan

Tuition payments are processed through F.A.C.T.S., a tuition management company. Each family signs a contract with F.A.C.T.S. authorizing automatic withdrawals from the family's bank account. The contract is a ten month plan, August through May. If the tuition bank draft is returned for funds rejection, a fee of \$30 will be assessed. Families may choose not to participate in the automatic withdrawal program by paying the full year's tuition and the activity fee by August 5th. Families who pay the full year's tuition upfront will receive a \$100 discount per student.

Activity Fee

In lieu of collecting a variety of fees throughout the year, an activity fee of \$300 is assessed to each student and will be added to tuition and collected over ten months through F.A.C.T.S. This fee covers the cost of the overnight field trips in the fall and spring, yearbook, testing fees, choir and art fees and museum entry fees. The only payments collected through the CHS office will be the application and registration fees, Great Britain tour, social events, choir outfits and consumable books that become the property of the student.

Parent Association Fee

All Covenant High School families pay a \$50 parent association fee per family with their tuition and are automatically members of the parent association. These fees provide opportunities for parents to partner with faculty and administration in advancing the school and supporting the teachers, while building community.

Application Fee – First Time Students Only

A non-refundable \$50 application fee is required with all applications for first-time students.

Annual Registration Fee

An annual, non-refundable registration fee is required for each CHS student. The fee is \$300 if paid on or before March 20 and \$350 thereafter. Students approved for registration will have a space reserved only after the registration fee has been paid.

Financial Assistance

Financial assistance is available to qualifying families. Families applying for assistance may request a financial aid form and confidentially submit this to the office in a sealed envelope addressed to Principal Miller.
