NNU Concurrent Credit Spring Classes

Students that enrolled for year-long concurrent credit in the fall do not need to enroll again for the Spring. The following classes at Covenant are available for Spring concurrent credit:

- Pre-Calculus: three college credits of Trigonometry (MATH1400).
- Spanish III: four college credits of Elementary Spanish (SPAN1020).
- Spanish IV: four college credits of Intermediate Spanish (SPAN2020).
- Spring Drama Performance: One credit of Communications (COMM2120).
